Executive Summary

A measurement of an institution's success in achieving its mission and objectives can be obtained through the tracking and monitoring of graduate feedback. Onondaga's Post-Graduation Survey is a tool used to measure overall satisfaction with the college experience while monitoring the continued academic and/or career success of recent graduates. Onondaga's Office of Institutional Planning, Assessment and Research monitors feedback and compiles information from its graduates regarding their employment status, continued education, and satisfaction with the OCC experience on an annual basis.

The 2014 survey was administered to 1,376 students from Onondaga's class of 2014 (consisting of all graduates of either a degree or certificate program from fall 2013- spring 2014). The outreach began two weeks prior to the 2014 commencement and concluded in spring 2015; 658 (47.8%) graduates participated in the survey.

Class of 2014 Degree Completion

1,390 degrees conferred upon the 1,376 graduates; 14 of which had earned dual degrees:

- 62.7% of degrees awarded were for completion of articulation/transfer programs: 27.7% were Associate in Arts (AA) degrees; 35.0% were Associate in Science (AS) degrees.
- 37.3% of degrees awarded were for completion of career programs: 32.7% were Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degrees; 4.5% were certificates for completing essential coursework typically required for entry-level positions.

2014 Post-Graduate Survey Report - Participation and Responses

Total Degrees Conferred

665 degrees conferred upon 658 survey participants; 7 of whom earned dual degrees:

- Consistent with overall degrees conferred for the class of 2014, the majority of degrees awarded to 2014 *Post-Graduate* survey participants (61.4%) were also awarded for completion of articulation/transfer programs: 28.6% were Associate in Arts (AA) degrees; 32.8% were Associate in Science (AS) degrees.
- 38.6% of degrees awarded were for completion of career programs: 36.4% were Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degrees; 2.3% were certificates for completing essential coursework typically required for entry-level positions.

Employment

- 203 (76.0%) of the survey participants who were planning to work after graduation are currently employed; of the graduates who are working:
 - 59.1% indicated full-time as their primary employment status.

- 60.8% indicated that their job or job duties are highly or slightly related to their program of study.
- 39.9% secured their current job in part, as a result of having attended Onondaga or by enrolling in your particular program(s) of study.
- 82.8% are employed in Onondaga County.
- 61.7% felt their OCC education had prepared them *to a great degree* or *to a moderate degree* for their current jobs

Continuing Education

- 379 (57.6%) of the survey participants indicated they are attending or plan on attending an educational institution with 12 months of graduation:
 - 77.8% are attending or plan on attending a 4-year institution.
 - 83.9% indicated full-time status at the next educational institution
 - 87.6% indicated their OCC credits transferred [to other educational institutions] without difficulty.
- 89.0% of participants indicated that they felt their OCC education had prepared them *to a great degree* or *to a moderate degree* for further study,

Educational Experience at OCC

- 97.4% of respondents indicated they had achieved or are in the process of achieving their educational goal.
- The majority of 2014 survey participants (91.5%) indicated they *definitely would* or *probably would* recommend Onondaga to others.

Introduction

The Office of Institutional Planning, Assessment and Research (IPAR) conducts an annual retrospective survey with a focus on recent Onondaga Community College graduates—conducted throughout the year starting at the time of commencement. The scope of the survey primarily focuses on collecting employment and continuing education data while also surveying graduates regarding their perception of their educational experience while attending Onondaga. Feedback provided by OCC’s graduates enables the College to remain informed of current alumni/graduate endeavors and successes and certain aspects of the student experience regarding Onondaga resources and programs.

At Onondaga, student success lies at the very core of the College’s mission. An important way OCC can measure its success in fulfilling its mission is through an analysis of data and feedback obtained from surveys directed toward recent graduates. This post-graduate survey can effectively provide insight into the student-alumni perspective for a myriad of functional areas throughout the College; data and feedback received can be used by Onondaga to inform important decisions.

Graduate data collected is utilized to measure levels of student satisfaction regarding several facets of their OCC experience, including:

- General Education curriculum;
- Academic department/discipline;
- Personal/professional skills development; and
- College resources and services.

The survey also addresses the graduates’ perception of their corresponding degree/certificate program-specific learning outcomes. Comments received are made available to appropriate academic department chairperson(s) or Program Coordinators, and resource/service-specific feedback is distributed to appropriate management personnel for continuous improvement purposes.

Once gathered, data and feedback are compiled, analyzed and delivered through this comprehensive *Post-Graduate Survey Report*. In addition to this report, per-program graduate employment and continuing education information are presented in the annual College Catalog.¹ IPAR also posts program-specific highlight data in WEAVE—OCC’s centralized online assessment and planning management system.

Graduate data is also used for the following:

- Sharing updated contact information with Alumni Relations personnel.
- Utilizing employment data collected to facilitate the College’s effort to create synergies with employers who are hiring OCC graduates.

Through dissemination and use of employment and continuing education data provided by its graduates, Onondaga and its stakeholders are granted the best possible opportunity to promote student success and continually improve programs and services for future students.

This survey report is organized into four major parts. Part I summarizes information regarding survey methodology. Part II displays degrees conferred and survey completion data. Part III highlights key survey findings from the four main sections of the questionnaire, educational goal, continuing education, employment and educational experience. Finally, Part IV provides quantitative findings for all of the questions presented to the recent graduates.

Part I: Methodology

Survey Population

The post-graduate survey was administered to all students with graduation dates between September 1st 2013 and August 31st 2014. The findings for the class of 2014 are based on 658 (47.8%) respondents from the population of 1,376 conferred graduates. Each student was afforded the opportunity to complete and return one survey regardless of the number of degrees earned.

Outreach

The survey outreach began roughly two months before the College's date of commencement (May 18, 2014) and continued until March 2015. From the onset, and continuing over the course of several weeks, electronic communications were sent directly to the email addresses of all probable graduates. For all non-responders, there were four subsequent reminders (responses were tracked for this purpose). Approximately six months from graduation another attempt was made to reach non-responders and to follow-up with students that had earned a workforce program degree or certificate and completed the initial survey but indicated that they were still seeking employment.

Format and Delivery

Surveys were administrated in two formats: electronic and via telephone.

Electronic: An email communication including a web survey link was sent to all recent graduates. The email addresses consisted of both OCC-issued and personal email addresses that were on file with the Registrar's office. A link to the survey was also hosted on the College's student website.

Telephone: Telephone surveys, which mirrored the online version, were conducted during the follow-up effort for graduates that were awarded workforce program degrees or certificates and had not responded to email communications. Graduates who had earned transfer degrees were not contacted via this method.

Part II: 2014 Graduate Data²

Overall Degrees Conferred

Figure 1: Aggregate degrees conferred upon graduates of the class of 2014, categorized by degree type. 62.7% of degrees awarded were for completion of transfer programs; 37.3% were awarded for completion of career programs.

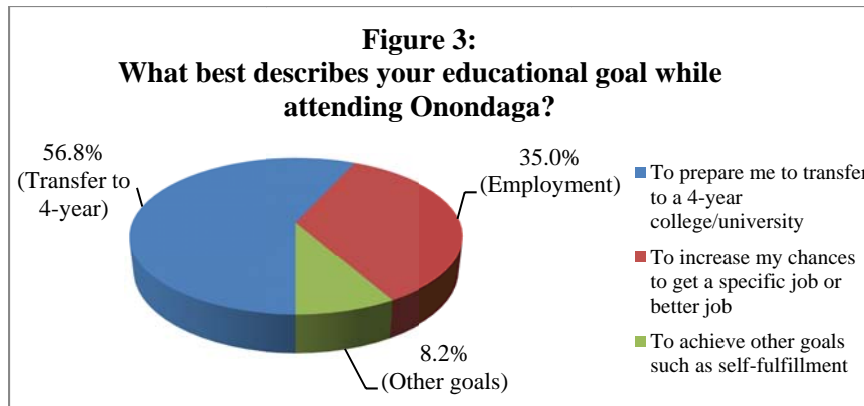
Figure 2: Aggregate Degrees Conferred (Survey Participants)

Part III: Summary of Key Findings

Section I: Educational Goal

Figure 3: 56.8% of 2014 survey participants indicated their educational goal while attending was to transfer to a 4-year college/university; 35.0% indicated their goal was to increase their chances to get a specific job or better job.



Figures 4: 97.4% of survey participants had achieved or are in the process of achieving their educational goal.

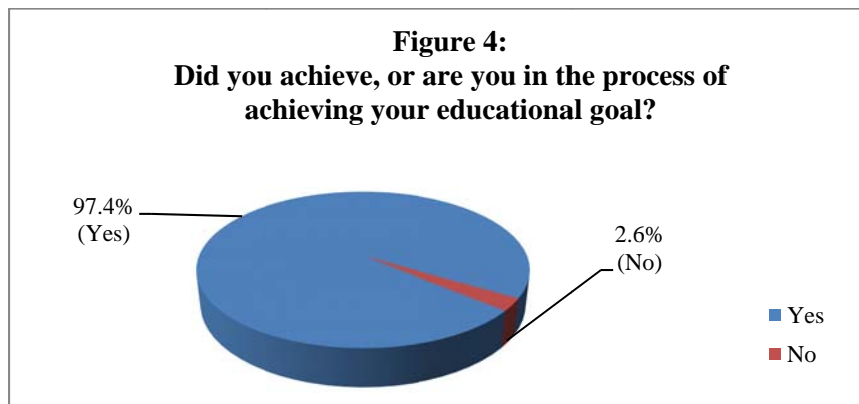
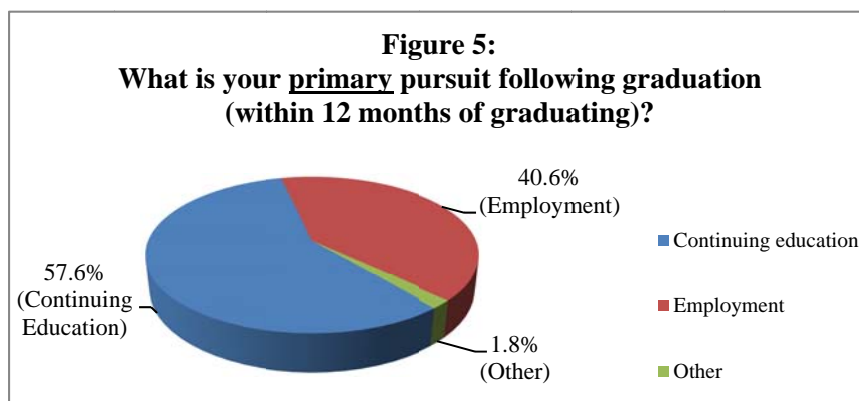


Figure 5: 57.6% of survey participants had plans to continue education within 12 months after graduation and 40.6% planned to be working or searching for work.

Figure 6: Of the 379 respondents with plans to continue education within 12 months of graduation, 77.8% are either attending or plan to attend a 4-year school.

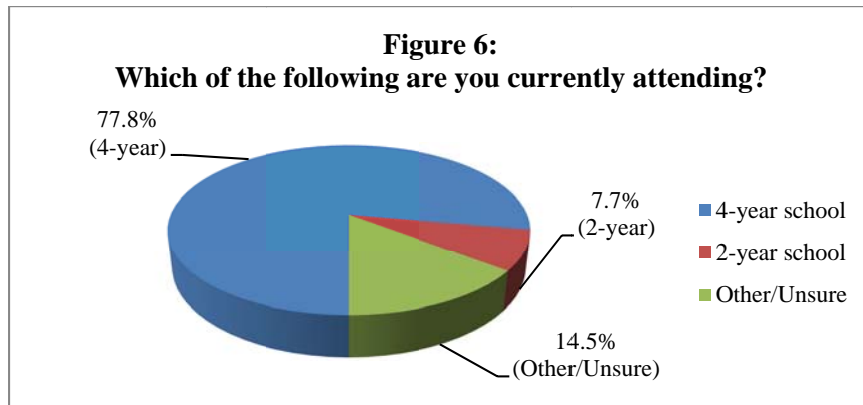


Figure 7: 92.1% of respondents continuing their education intend on completing a bachelor's degree or higher.

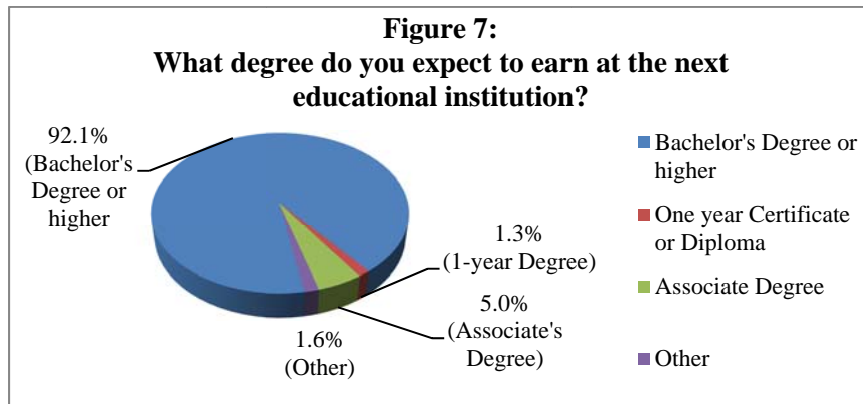


Figure 8: 83.9% indicated their student status as full-time.

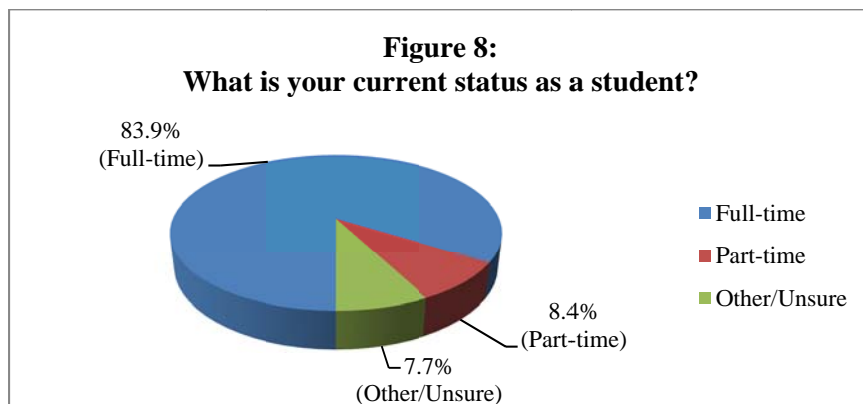


Figure 9: 87.6% of 2014 survey participants indicated their OCC credits transferred without difficulty.

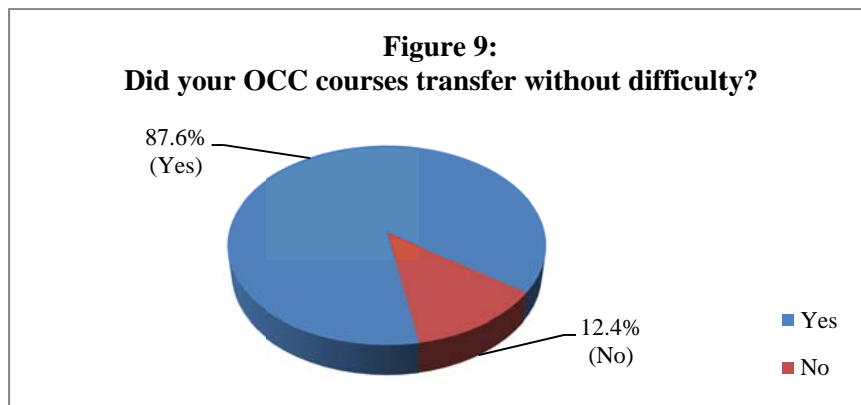


Figure 10: 89.0% of 2014 survey participants currently attending an educational institution indicated OCC prepared them *to a great degree* or *to a moderate degree* for further study.

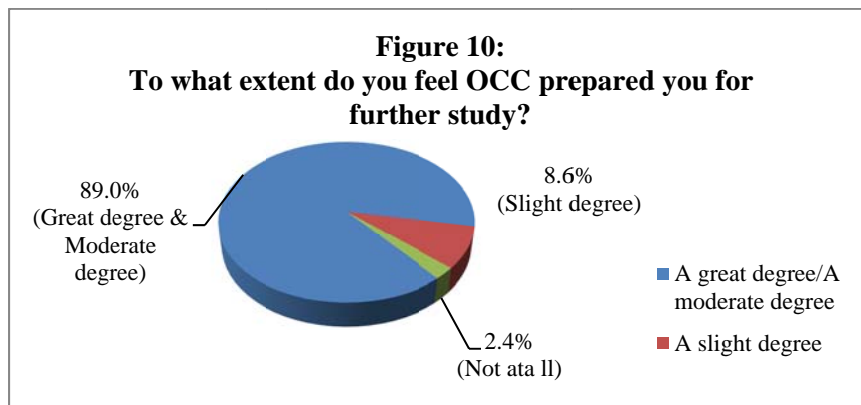


Figure 11: 4-year Institutions listed most frequently By 2014 Survey Participants.³

Figure 12: Of the respondents with plans to work or search for work within 12 months of graduation, 76.0% are employed.

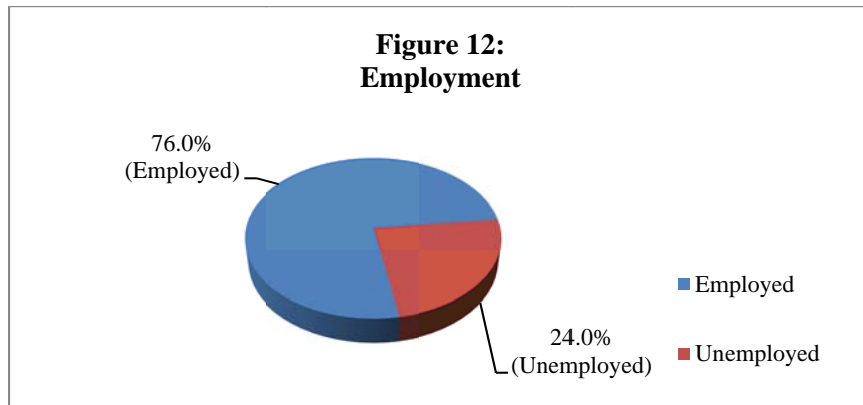


Figure 13: Of the currently employed survey participants, 59.1% listed their employment status as full-time.

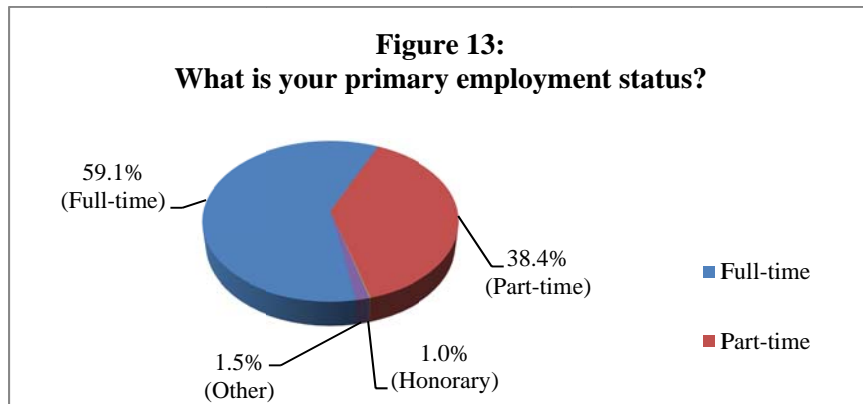


Figure 14: 39.9% of the currently employed indicated they secured their current job in part, as a result of attending Onondaga or by enrolling in their particular program(s) of study.

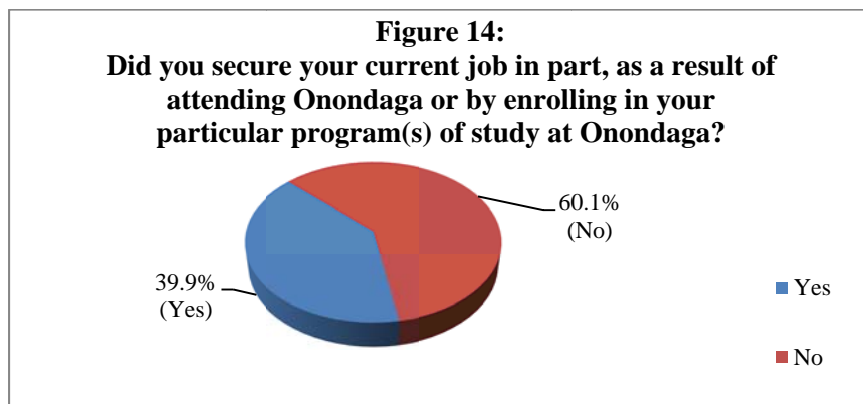


Figure 15: 82.8% of the currently employed survey participants said they were working in Onondaga County.

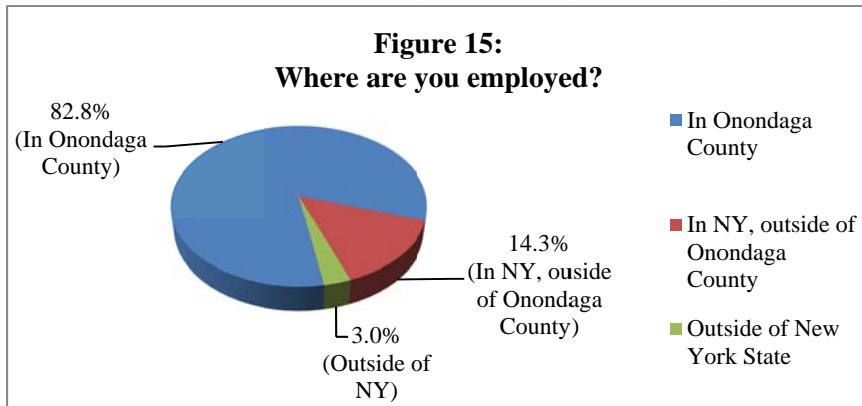


Figure 16: 41.9% of employed survey participants reported annual salaries of \$25,000 or higher; the majority (58.1%) reported annual salaries of less than \$25,000.

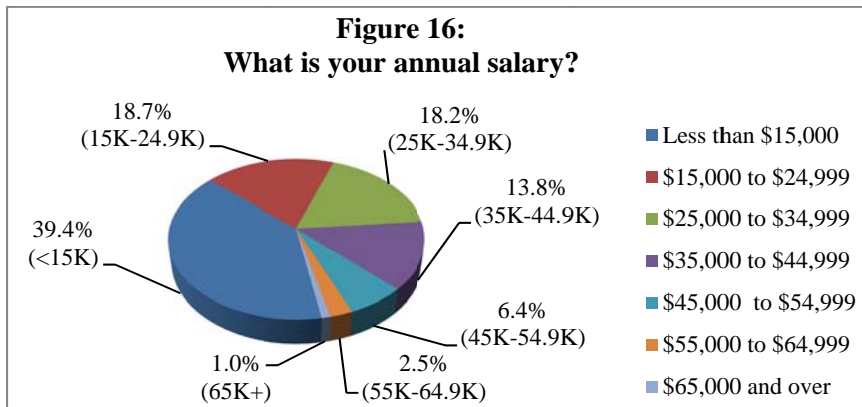


Figure 17: 60.8% of employed survey participants indicated their occupations were *highly related* or *slightly related* to their programs of study at Onondaga.

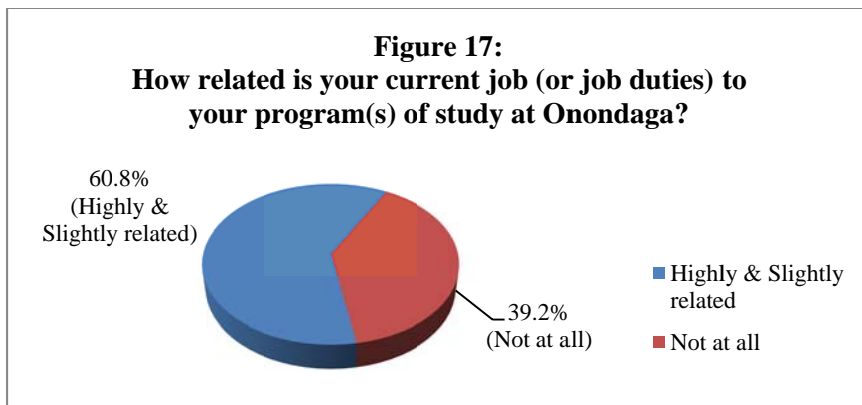


Figure 18: 61.7% of employed survey participants indicated their Onondaga education prepared them *to a great degree or to a moderate degree* for their current jobs.

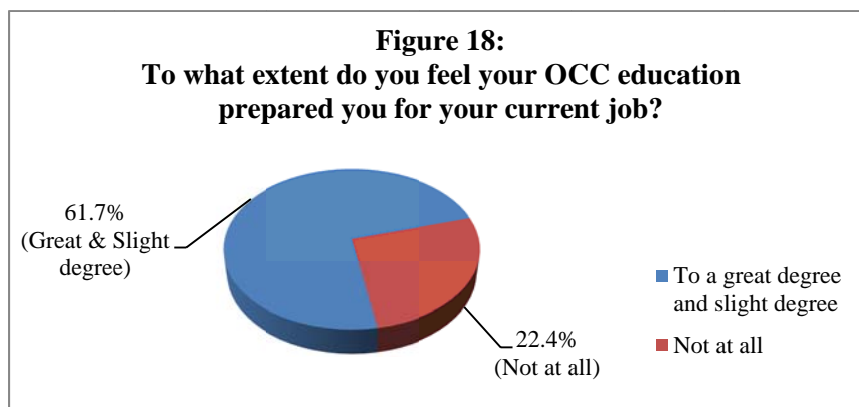


Figure 19: Full-time Employers listed most frequently by 2014 survey participants.⁴

Additional Information

Onondaga's 2011-2016 [strategic plan](#) relies upon a variety of key indicators and performance data collected from academic departments and administrative divisions/departments to assess College progress toward meeting targets specified within the plan. The assessment process is used to celebrate success and identify opportunities for improvement at both the institutional and department levels.

As stated by the current strategic plan's Goal 4. Outcome 6: *100% of graduates of AAS degree programs who desire immediate employment upon graduation will obtain a job related to their field of study within one year.* This measurement requires the College to obtain data and feedback from OCC graduates regarding their current employment status; therefore, this outcome has subsequently been incorporated into the standard IPAR post-graduate survey's category of career-related questions.

In accordance with this annual reporting requirement, 68.7% (79 of 115) of employed respondents are employed in a field *highly related* or *slightly related* to their program of study.⁵

Figure 20: 86.0% of 2014 survey participants had been full-time students while attending OCC.

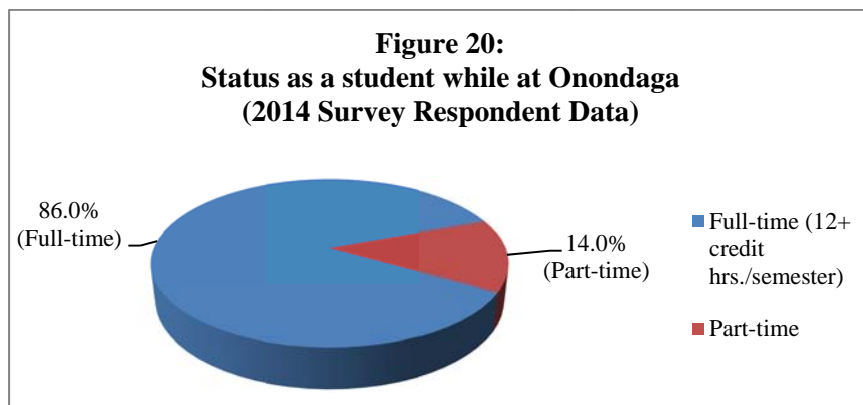


Figure 21: 68.1% of 2014 survey participants indicated that they completed their degree or certificate in two and a half years or less.

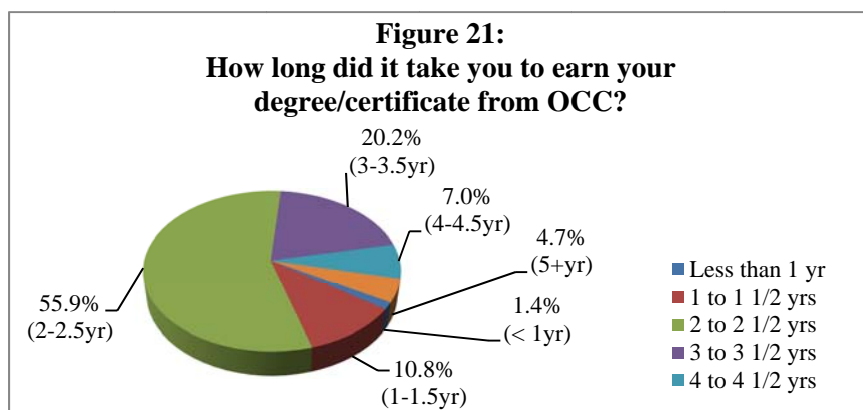


Figure 22: (next page): In each of the areas relating to the College’s general student learning outcomes, every category presented received a rating higher than 80.0%—with survey participants indicating that they either *strongly agree* or *agree* with the statements presented to them:

- 93.5% of survey participants *strongly agree* or *agree* that their overall educational experience helped them to think critically and solve problems.

- 93.2% of survey participants *strongly agree* or *agree* that their overall educational experience helped to conduct themselves in an ethical and professional manner.

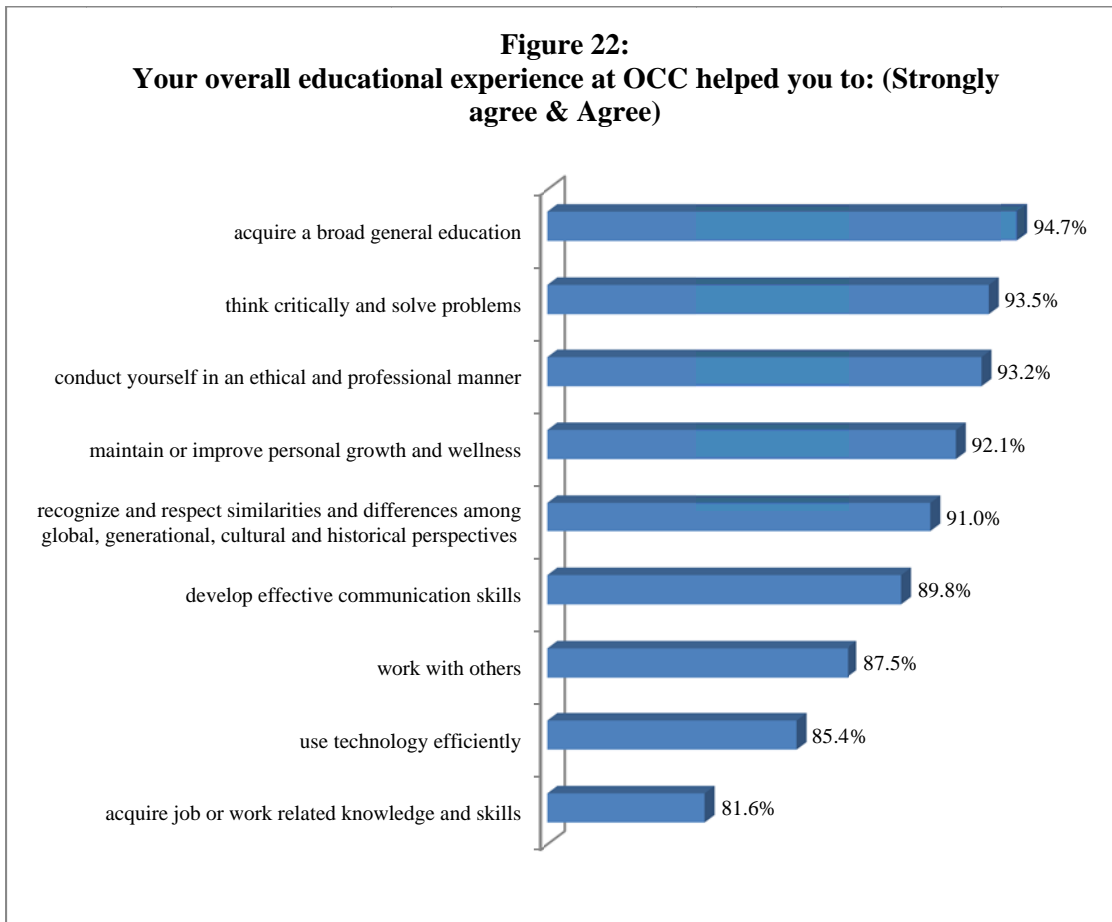


Figure 23 (next page): In each of the areas relating to the College’s resources and services, 11 of the 15 categories received a satisfaction rating (*very satisfied* or *satisfied*) above 80%.

- 97.3% of participants indicated they were *very satisfied* or *satisfied* with the library services.
- 95.3% of participants indicated they were *very satisfied* or *satisfied* with their overall experience with courses within their program of study
- 93.4% of participants indicated they were *very satisfied* or *satisfied* with the overall educational experience at OCC
- 93.2% of participants indicated they were *very satisfied* or *satisfied* with their overall experience with courses outside of their program of study

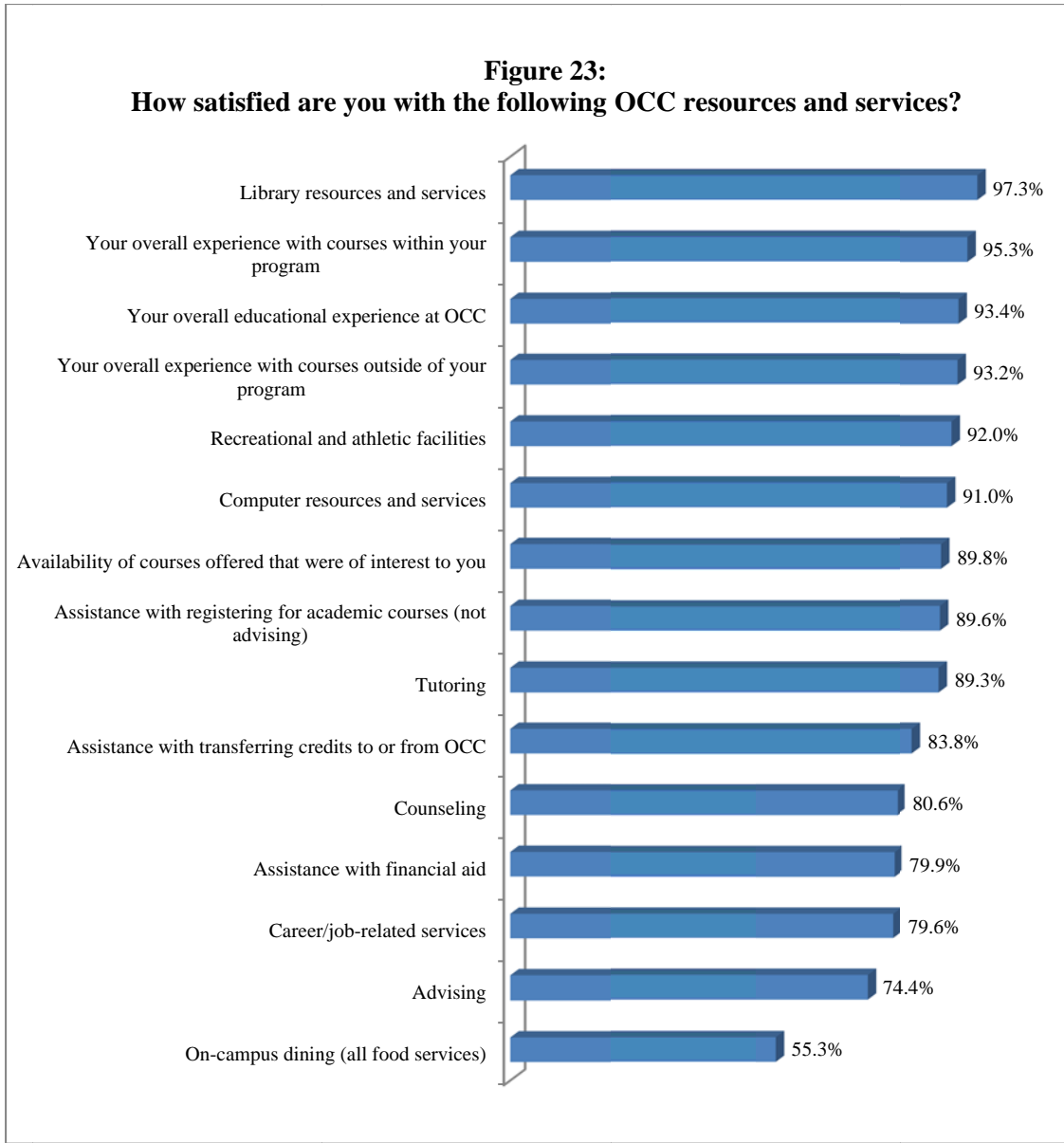
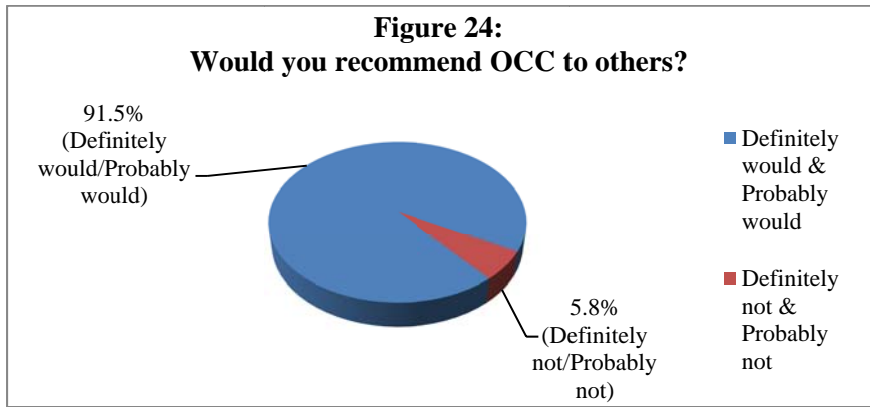


Figure 24: A vast majority (91.5%) of respondents indicated they *definitely would* or *probably would* recommend OCC to others.
