- ◆ OPC will seek permission from the student/family-of-student to follow up with the student's school counselor, who will arrange to discuss the student's interest in OPC with the student/family-of-student.
- ◆ OPC will invite the student and family to meet with OPC staff and to attend an upcoming OPC (or OCC) event of the student's/family's choice, so that they can become familiar with OPC and its services.
- ◆ The student/family-of-student will be given forms to grant permission for OPC staff to work collaboratively with the student's school counselor and special educator to coordinate transition planning that will help support the student's expressed goals and interests in OPC.
