As part of the recent assessment completed by the CLC in spring of 2024, one of the recommendations from the group was to inform the campus community of the work taking place on a regular basis—hence the creation of this newsletter which will be supplied after each scheduled meeting. At the February 21, 2025 meeting, the following agenda items were covered:

- Institutional Effectiveness Plan—Drs. Choseed and Vormwald, Co-chairs of the IE Committee, provided a updated version to their plan. One of the updates was that the non-academic departments will move to operational plans instead of five-year administrative reviews. The plan was approved unanimously.
- Strategic Plan—Dr. Hilton continued a discussion on the mission and vision statements of the college. He noted that we did not review them in advance of the development of the current strategic plan due to time constraints. To be sure we are in alignment with Middle States standards, we are looking at the development of a formal review process, but want to be sure we receive campus input in the meantime. Our Student Government members have developed a survey and the consensus was to move this to a campus-wide survey, with specific questions geared towards the various constituents on campus (Faculty, SGA, OCCAC, CSEA, etc.). Each group will take the survey back to their own groups for review with responses due back to CLC before spring break. CLC will then review it one more time at the March meeting before possible dissemination to campus.
- Middle States: Dr. Choseed provided an update on the Art of Accreditation event that was held earlier that day.
- Onondaga Nation Land Acknowledgement: Dr. Shawn Wiemann informed the members that the Onondaga Nation has approved use of the land acknowledgement that OCC previously developed. While a strategy for its use has not been created just yet, we anticipate it being said prior to sporting events, commencement, etc. We are planning a grand opening of the Indigenous Student Center and a formal presentation on the land acknowledgement for April 2. More information will be made available soon.
- Campus Climate Survey Workgroup: S. Whalen provided an update from the Campus Climate Survey Workgroup. After the successful *Leading at the Speed of Trust* training, the workgroup has suggested that the employees selected as facilitators continue with their training and look at hosting additional opportunities on campus.
