At the October 17, 2025 meeting, the following agenda items were covered:

- Members received updates on representation on the Data Governance Committee and an additional charge on physical space. Reminders will go to Committee Chairs to be sure their webpages are current. Dr. Awuah will provide a mid-point review on the Strategic Plan for Middle States evidence.
- A conversation was had surrounding student orientation (online and in person) and the content that is covered as it relates to Box of Books and D2L. More conversations will take place at the next meeting as we look at the possibility of laptops being included in Box of Books and ways in which we can encourage students to complete the D2L tutorials.
- More updates will be available at the next meeting on Leading at the Speed of Trust training and accessible computer labs.
- Dr. Agatha Awuah provided an overview of the new SUNY Academic Momentum initiative. More conversations will take place at the next CLC meeting.
- Members will begin preparing for the next CLC assessment in spring of 2026.
- Members will be voting at the December meeting on the suggested revisions to the bylaws.
- The conversation surrounding library evening hours continued with input from SGA. They feel the later hours are important and that they remain in place, particularly for the adult learners who take evening classes. Funding has been provided to cover the continued late hours.
- The Involve App issue was resolved, and conversations will continue on the SUNY Shared Governance award.
- The next CLC meeting is scheduled for November 21, 2025.
