New Business

Externally Funded Projects

Trustee Alicea introduced Nicole Schlater, Associate Vice President for Grants Administration, to provide an update on current externally funded projects. Ms. Schlater began with an overview of active grants and the funds attributed to each – federal, state, and local/private. She then reviewed the active grant list that was provided to the Trustees, and discussed federal funding cancellations and potential cuts, including NSF, NEH, and TRIO grants to name a few. She also discussed where things stand currently and what actions are underway to help with these cuts. She then reviewed current program highlights, including support for students, experiential learning, and Earn-and-Learn, as well as opportunities for program capacity building and expansion. Ms. Schlater continued with updates on the current simulation labs being built on campus, including the Micron Cleanroom Simulation Lab and the Health Pathway programs lab. She explained the work taking place over the summer and continued planning for 2025-2026.
