RESOLUTION TO CONGRATULATE THE ONONDAGA COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
MEN'S NJCAA DIVISION III TRIPLE JUMP NATIONAL CHAMPION  
NY'QUEZ MADISON**

**WHEREAS**, Onondaga Community College student Ny'Quez Madison demonstrated remarkable sportsmanship, teamwork, athletic talent and determination throughout the 2024-25 Track and Field season; and

**WHEREAS**, student Ny'Quez came to OCC from Liverpool Central School District where he was active in Track and Field and Football. In his freshman year at OCC on the Track and Field Team, Ny'Quez had a very successful season. At the NJCAA Division 3 Regional Championship, he took 1st in the Men's Long Jump with a jump of 6.53m and took 1st in the Triple Jump with a jump of 12.59m. He also took 1<sup>st</sup> with three of his OCC teammates in the Men's 4x100m Relay with a time of 43.67. The OCC Track and Field team finished second at the Region 3 Championships; and

**WHEREAS**, the NJCAA Division 3 Outdoor Track and Field National Championship was hosted at Mohawk Valley Community College on May 9 – 11, 2025. On day one, Ny'Quez finished in 1st place in the Men's Triple Jump. His mark of 13.97m (45'10 ft) came on his very last jump of the meet, also resetting the OCC school record. He also finished third in the Men's Long jump with a jump of 6.81m, guaranteeing him All-American status; and

**WHEREAS**, Ny'Quez, a Business major at OCC, demonstrated teamwork, skill, and a commitment to excellence, enabling him to achieve at the highest levels within his sport, and his dedication and accomplishments have served as an inspiration to members of the OCC family as well as members of the surrounding community who supported him throughout the season;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Onondaga Community College Board of Trustees expresses its heartfelt appreciation and congratulations to Athletic Director Michael Borsz, Track and Field Head Coach Taylor Bouchard, and student Ny'Quez Madison who will be remembered for the pride they have brought to the Onondaga Community College campus and to our community as a result of their outstanding achievements.
