WHEREAS, College Policies B1, B16, D6, G10, G12 and G13 are being updated; Policies C17, C18, and G14 are new; and

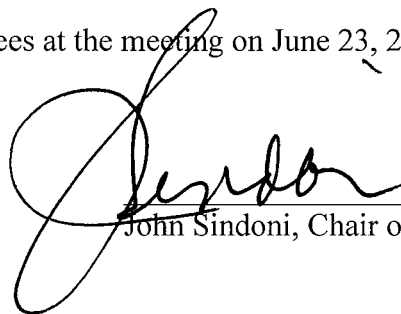
WHEREAS, the proposed College policy updates were presented to the Board at its June 23, 2026, meeting and have been recommended by the President; and

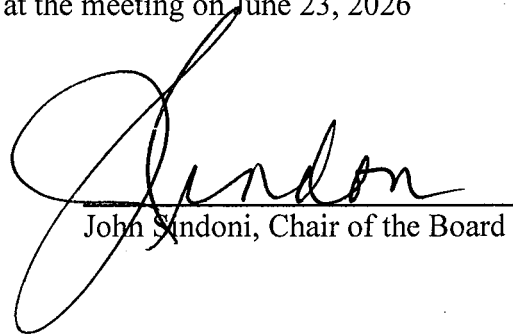

WHEREAS, the Onondaga Community College Board of Trustees has the authority to designate the official days of the Onondaga Community College Commencement ceremonies; and

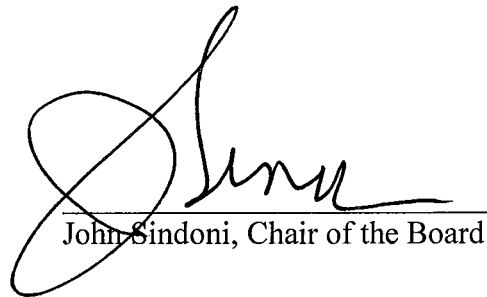

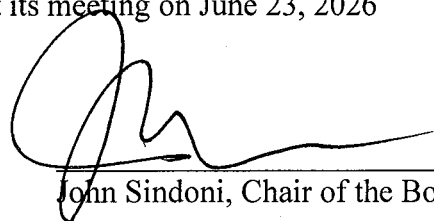
WHEREAS, Hannah dedicated her fall 2025 season to the Women's Soccer Team again, but for the Winter Track and Field Season, she became the first female athlete to qualify for the National Indoor Track and Field Championships. She began the 2026 Outdoor Track and Field season much like the previous year – very successfully. During the season, Hannah was consistently ranked #1 for the Heptathlon. At the NJCAA Region 3 Outdoor Track and Field Championships in May 2026, Hannah added another regional championship in the 400m hurdles and a top-three finish in the javelin to her already impressive season. She was named both Region 3 Track Athlete of the Year and Region 3 Field Athlete of the Year. She once again reached the NJCAA Division 3 Outdoor Track and Field National Championships, where she secured the National Championship in 400m hurdles with a time of 1:08:97, making her the first National Champion at any level from Chittenango, NY. She also finished as runner-up in the Heptathlon; and

WHEREAS, Hannah, who plans to take a gap year, has demonstrated teamwork, skill, and a commitment to excellence, enabling her to achieve at the highest levels within her sport, and her dedication and accomplishments have served as an inspiration to members of the OCC family as well as members of the surrounding community who supported her throughout the season. 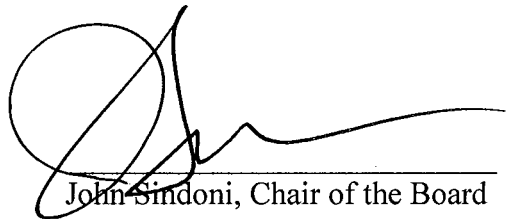
WHEREAS, the Onondaga Community College Board of Trustees supports the President's efforts to build and retain a strong and competent management team; and
